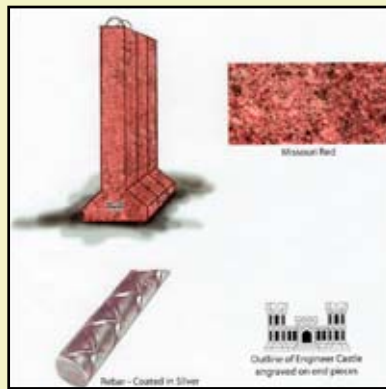

**T**he Warrior Ethos stands as a reminder of our duty to remember those brave Engineers who gave their lives for their friends, their families and our nation during this global war on terror. In that regard, the Army Engineer Association (AEA), is accepting donations to support the design and construction of the Memorial Wall for Fallen Engineers to be located in the "Sapper Grove" at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri—home of the Army Engineer Regiment.

The **Memorial** will take the form of "T-Walls"—a familiar object easily recognized by all who have served this war. These barriers provide protection at base camps and combat outposts in Iraq and Afghanistan and are aptly related to today's Engineer mission.

The T-Walls at the Memorial will be constructed of Missouri granite as depicted in the graphic. Included will be a short description of the named operation, and every Fallen Engineer's name and organization will be suitably engraved.

*Members of the Engineer Regiment and others, and ESPECIALLY those assigned to Army Engineer organizations and units now serving, are asked to contribute either individually or as a group to this most worthy cause. **Individual Contributions:**

**ENGINEER SPONSOR:** Any amount between \$20 and \$200. Donor's name to be published in Army Engineer magazine.

**ENGINEER BENEFACTOR:** \$201-\$1000. Donor's name and unit affiliation to be published in Army Engineer magazine **plus** included on an appropriately designed plaque donated by the AEA to the Engineer Regiment at Fort Leonard Wood.

**Unit Contributions:**

**SILVER ENGINEER:** \$1001-\$5000. Unit designation to be published in Army Engineer magazine **plus** included on an appropriately designed plaque donated by the AEA to the Engineer Regiment at Fort Leonard Wood.

**GOLD ENGINEER:** \$5001 and above: Unit designation to be published in Army Engineer magazine **plus** included on an appropriately designed plaque donated by the AEA to the Engineer Regiment at Fort Leonard Wood **plus** the unit will be presented with a replica of the plaque for local display as desired.
